



Responsible Host Pledge

The lure of alcohol and illicit drugs is powerful. These dangerous substances affect our entire community. You can help our youth make the right choices concerning the use of alcohol and drugs by promoting your dwelling as a “Responsible Host” residence, a place where teens will not be exposed to these substances.

As a Responsible Host participant, I pledge:

1. I will not allow parties in my home when I am not present.
2. I will be an active chaperone at parties in my home.
3. I will not serve, nor willingly allow, minors to consume alcohol or illicit drugs in my home or on my property.
4. I will welcome parents/guardians of youths attending a party at my home to call and check on party details, times, supervision, and/or any other concerns.
5. I will not hesitate to call a parent/guardian if a problem arises with their youth in my home.
6. I will encourage my son/daughter to only attend parties at addresses listed on the Responsible Host data base.
7. I will monitor and control the number of people who attend parties at my home. I will call the police if the party gets out of hand or if uninvited guests refuse to leave.
8. I will discuss with my son or daughter the ramifications of advertising or posting party information on the Internet or any other medium.
9. I will share the contents of this pledge with my entire family.
